Total of 103 students along with 4 staffs attended the visit. Satish Dhawan Space Centre - SDSC is a rocket launch centre operated by Indian Space Research Organisation. It is located in Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh. Sriharikota Range was renamed in 2002 after ISRO's former chairman Satish Dhawan.

The objective of the visit was to provide a Technical Exposure to the students about Space Technology and advancements in Technology.
