The college had the privilege to invite the eminent personalities like **B.N.SENTHAL KUMAR**, **CH.NAGARAJU**, for valedictory function. Both the chief guests inspired the students with their speeches. The event was an appropriate platform for students to come up with their own innovative ideas in their respective streams. Some students are actively participated as volunteers and some proved their skills in various events. In this event Over 700 people attended the event and around 150 students from various colleges also participated.



6. On 22rd February Narayana engineering college, Nellore organized a **“cancer awareness program for girls”** for the all EEE students by Dr.Srinivasulu, Ramachandra hospitals Nellore.

The elaborate presentation covered aspects like: Probable Symptoms that cause breast cancer, ways to identify it in early stages to be cured off like Dimpling, Puckering, Stretching pain in the back etc., The factors causing cancer are genetic, physiological, dietary,

environmental and life style. They suggested precautionary measures like avoiding cholesterol rich fat diet, alcohol intake, reducing obesity based on the BMI standard, curtailing use of tobacco, proper clothing, benefits of breast feeding etc., Later on, they briefed the participants on methods of early detection such as clinical Tests, mammography and ultra sound scanning. They advised the girl-students to be conservative, follow healthy food containing fibre rich foods with Vitamin A, E and C, Beta carotenes and selenium supplements.

The main objective of this program is to create awareness on cancer especially for girls regarding this deadly disease.



7. On 23rd February Narayana engineering college, Nellore organized a “cancer awareness program” for the all EEE students by Dr.Srinivasulu, Ramachandra hospitals Nellore.

In this session he discussed the Objectives of the Cancer Awareness and Educational Programmes:

- To create awareness of the disease.
- To help people recognize the early signs and symptoms of cancer, thus enabling them to seek treatment at an early stage. The programme encourages the participants to seek prompt medical attention for symptoms which may include lumps, sores, bleeding, hoarseness, weight loss and persistent indigestion/cough/pain, etc.
- To educate people about the key risk factors of cancer since more than 30% of cancer cases could be prevented by modifying lifestyle or avoiding the key risk factors.
- To inform people about the importance of cancer check-ups at an early stage.



8. On 24/2/17 EEE II B.Tech students got permission to visit Nippo factory, under the guidance of our department. In the factory students observed the process of battery manufacturing .We started from the college at 7.00a.m in our college bus and we reached our destination at 10.45 a.m. After reaching the factory the professional people in the factory explained the components and their working. Also they showed the latest technology equipments and its fast working process.

Such industrial visits organized by Narayana engineering college helps the students to enhance their practical knowledge on industrial sites.
