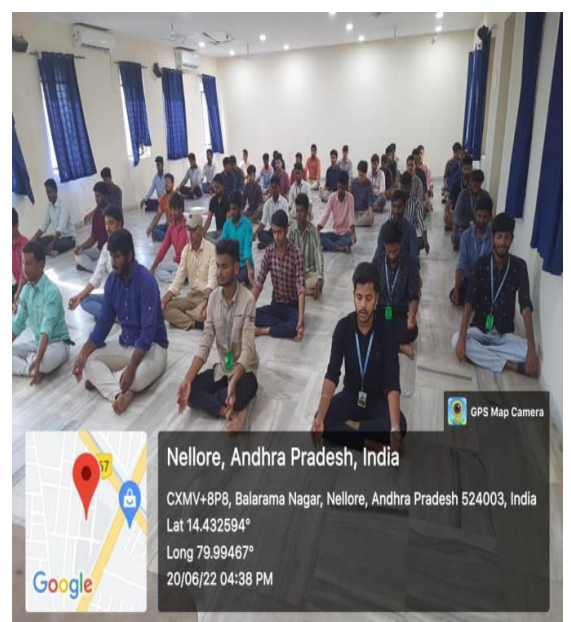
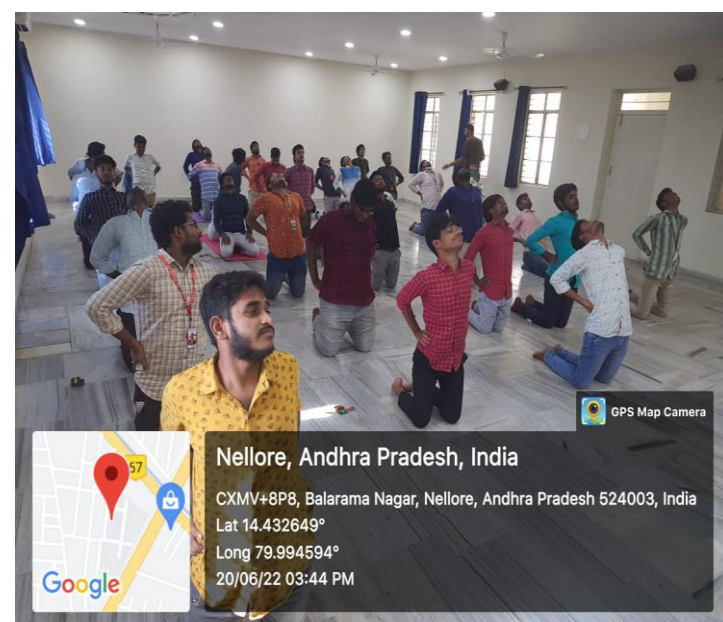

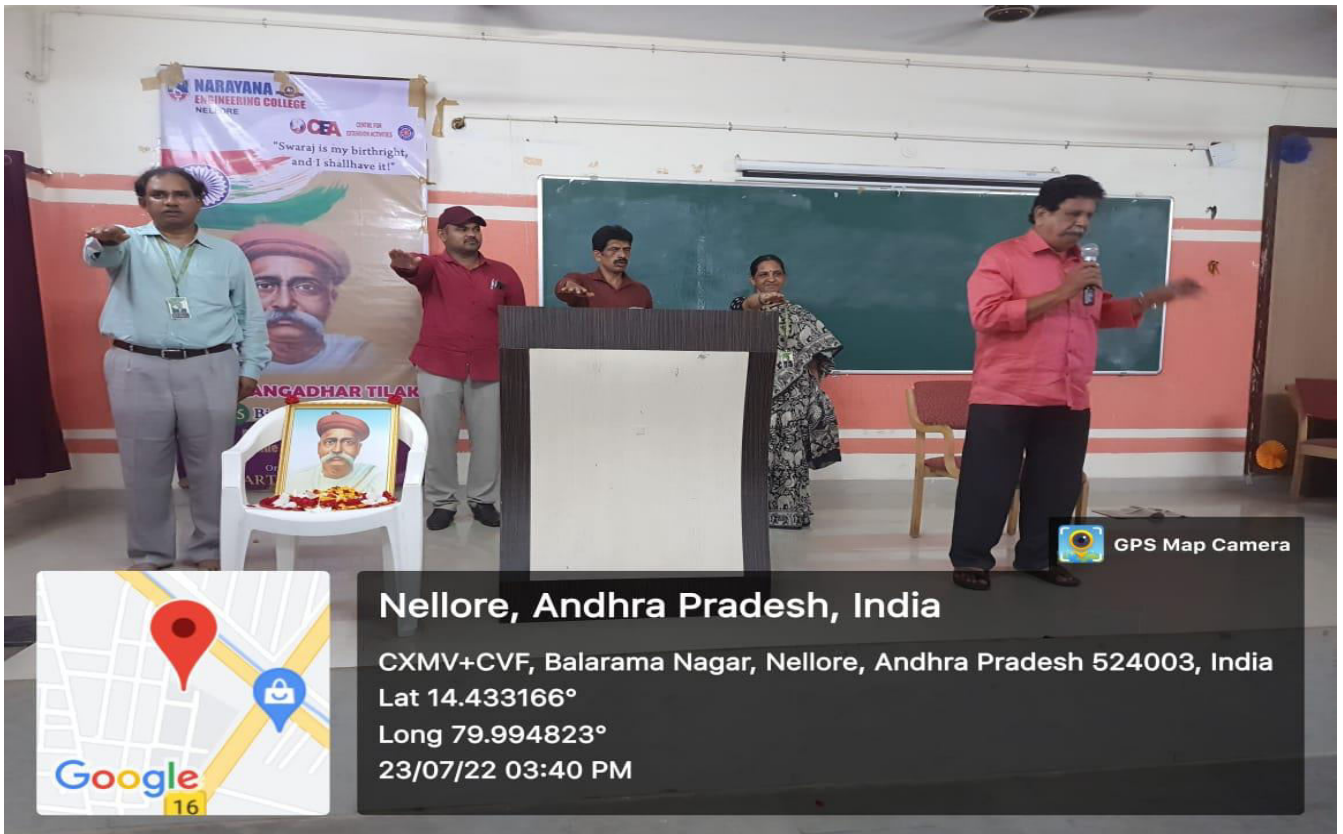

- The richness and the importance of Indian nationalists have been understood.



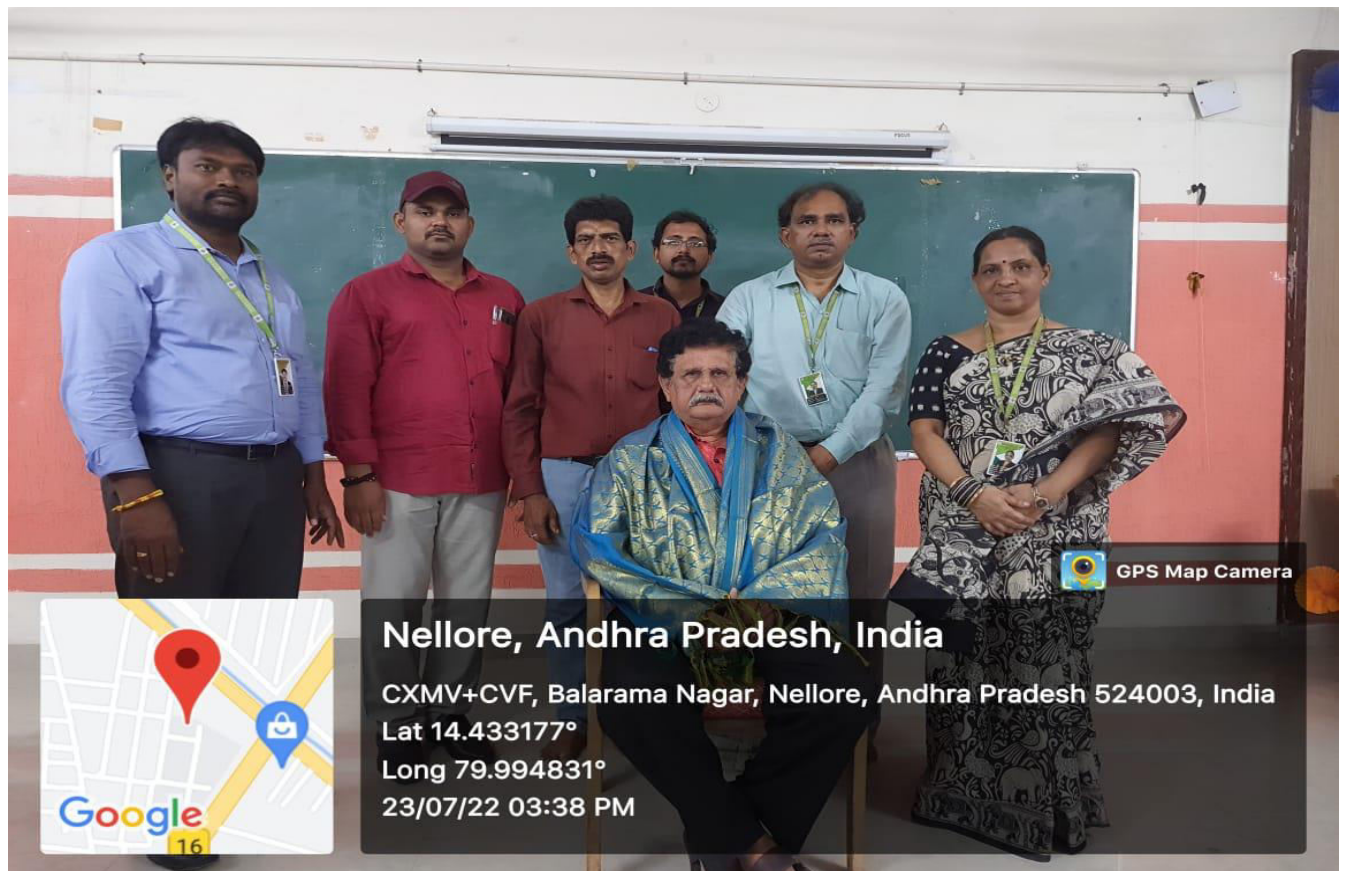

Brief Report of the Event:

NSS Unit of Narayana Engineering College, Nellore has conducted “**Awareness Program on History of our National Flag**” on **06-08-2022** from **11:30 am** at Visveswaraiah Auditorium (i.e. **Faradays Block**).

The Speaker Mrs Guduru Lakshmi, in her Guest lecture said that every free nation of the world has its own flag. It is a symbol of a free country. The National Flag of India

was adopted in its present form during the meeting of Constituent Assembly held on the 22 July 1947, a few days before India's independence from the British on 15 August, 1947. It served as the national flag of the Dominion of India between 15 August 1947 and 26 January 1950 and that of the Republic of India thereafter. In India, the term "tricolour" refers to the Indian national flag.

The National flag of India is a horizontal tricolor of deep saffron (kesari) at the top, white in the middle and dark green at the bottom in equal proportion. The ratio of width of the flag to its length is two to three. In the centre of the white band is a navy blue wheel which represents the chakra. Its design is that of the wheel which appears on the abacus of the Sarnath Lion Capital of Ashoka. Its diameter approximates to the width of the white band and it has 24 spokes.

Colours of the Flag

In the national flag of India the top band is of Saffron colour, indicating the strength and courage of the country. The white middle band indicates peace and truth with Dharma Chakra. The last band is green in colour shows the fertility, growth and auspiciousness of the land.

The Chakra

This Dharma Chakra depicted the "wheel of the law" in the Sarnath Lion Capital made by the 3rd-century BC Mauryan Emperor Ashoka. The chakra intends to show that there is life in movement and death in stagnation.

Flag Code

On 26th January 2002, the Indian flag code was modified and after several years of independence, the citizens of India were finally allowed to hoist the Indian flag over their homes, offices and factories on any day and not just National days as was the case earlier. Now Indians can proudly display the national flag anywhere and anytime, as long as the provisions of the Flag Code are strictly followed to avoid any disrespect to the tricolour. For the sake of convenience, Flag Code of India, 2002, has been divided into three parts. Part I of the Code contains general description of the National Flag.

Part II of the Code is devoted to the display of the National Flag by members of public, private organizations, educational institutions, etc. Part III of the Code relates to display of the National Flag by Central and State governments and their organisations and agencies.

There are some rules and regulations upon how to fly the flag, based on the 26 January 2002 legislation.

The Do's:

- The National Flag may be hoisted in educational institutions (schools, colleges, sports camps, scout camps, etc.) to inspire respect for the Flag. An oath of allegiance has been included in the flag hoisting in schools.
- A member of public, a private organization or an educational institution may hoist/display the National Flag on all days and occasions, ceremonial or otherwise consistent with the dignity and honour of the National Flag.
- Section 2 of the new code accepts the right of all private citizens to fly the flag on their premises.

The Don'ts:

The flag cannot be used for communal gains, drapery, or clothes. As far as possible, it should be flown from sunrise to sunset, irrespective of the weather.

The flag cannot be intentionally allowed to touch the ground or the floor or trail in water. It cannot be draped over the hood, top, and sides or back of vehicles, trains, boats or aircraft.

No other flag or bunting can be placed higher than the flag. Also, no object, including flowers or garlands or emblems can be placed on or above the flag. The tricolour cannot be used as a festoon, rosette or bunting.

The big day for India came when Lord Mountbatten announced the decision to free India. The need to have a Flag that is acceptable to all parties was realized and an ad-hoc flag committee was headed by Dr. Rajendra Prasad to design the flag for free India. Gandhiji's consent was taken and Pingley Venkayya's flag was decided to be modified. Instead of the Charkha, the emblem of Ashoka's Sarnath pillar, the wheel, was decided upon. None of the colours had any communal significance. The National Flag was adopted on 22 July, 1947.

Faculty members and students have participated in the Guest Lecture of History on National Flag and made the event grand success.



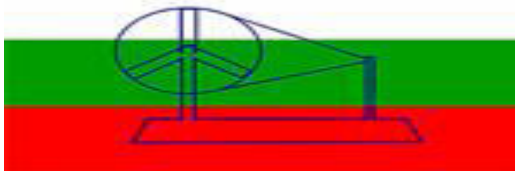

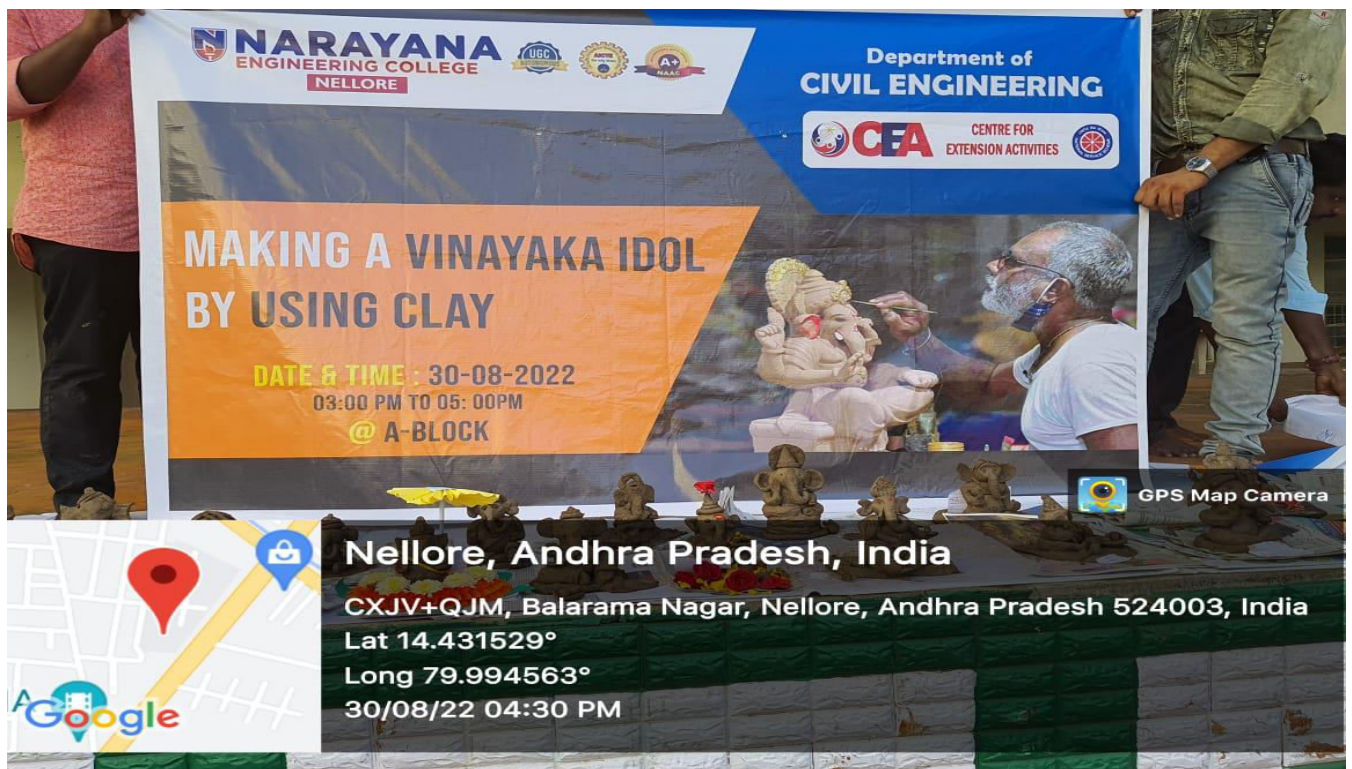

Brief Report of the Event:

Department of CSE in association with NSS Unit organized an **Awareness Programme on “WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY”** at our campus on 10.09.2022. The objective of this camp is to provide awareness among the students on prevention of suicide. A welcome note by a student Volunteer of NSS and introduced the Guest Speaker of the day Dr.V.Suresh Babu (**Psychiatrist**), Nellore.

A brief introduction on "World Suicide Prevention Day," by Dr. V. Suresh Babu went on to discuss in detail the risk factors for suicide, including stressful life events, a lack of social belongingness, smoking, substance abuse, conflicting relationships, and alienation. He also emphasised that childhood experiences can also have a significant impact on a person's decision to commit suicide. He emphasised that the leading factor in suicides is "depression."

He emphasised the fact that young people are particularly vulnerable to depression and suicide because they are going through a transitional period, are subject to peer pressure, and frequently experience stressful life events like academic or career setbacks that may result in increased alcohol consumption. Finally, he declared the slogan of the Event, "Catch Hope, Not Rope," and opened the floor to student questions.

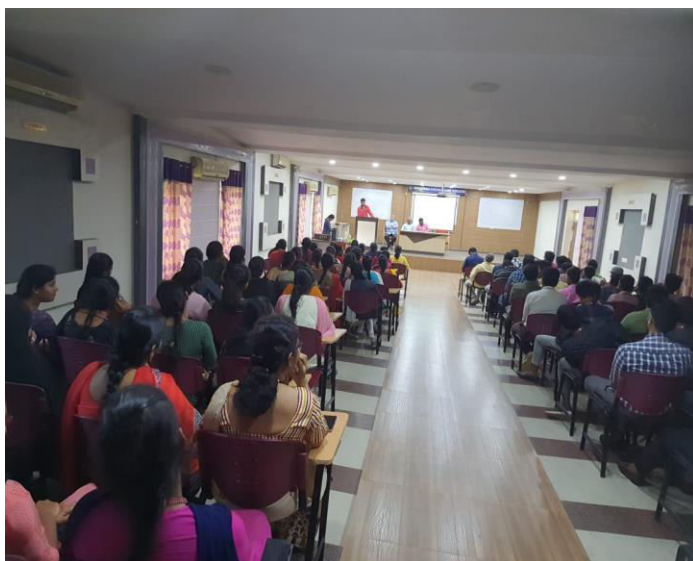

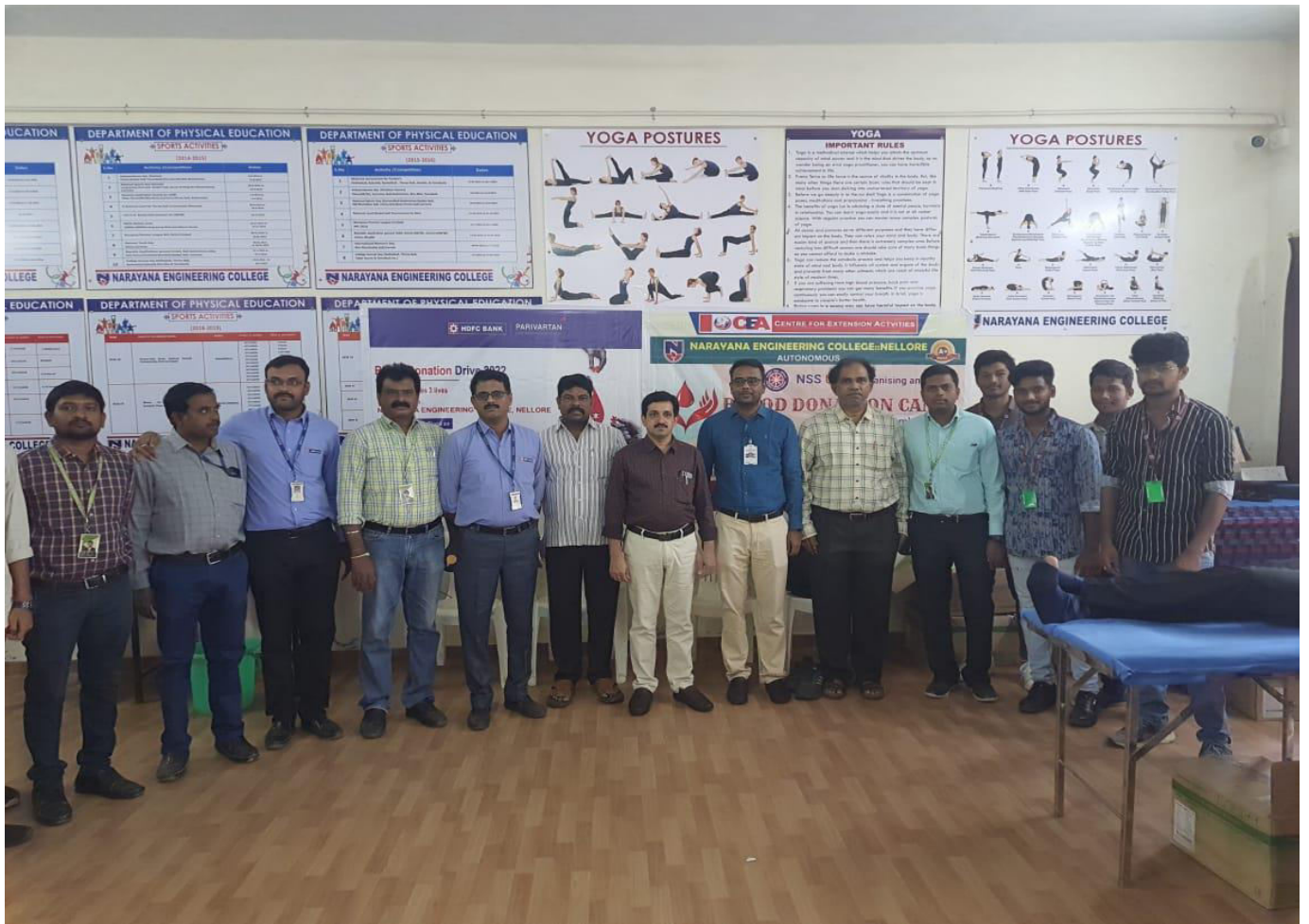
Brief Report of the Event:

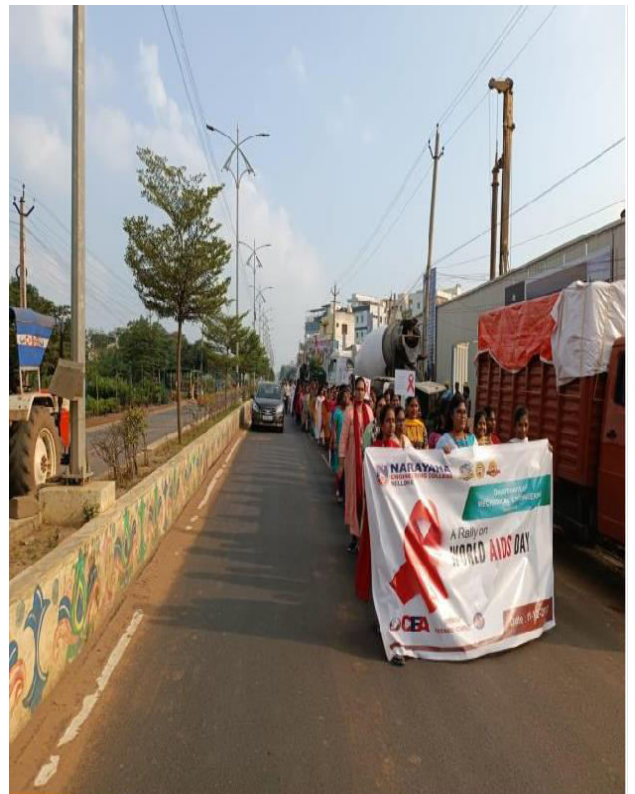

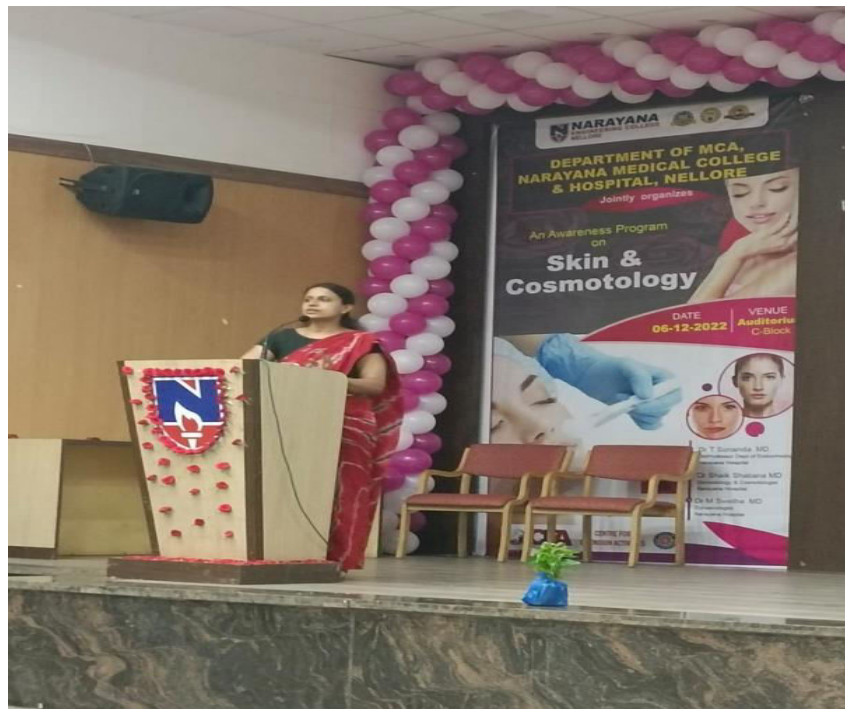

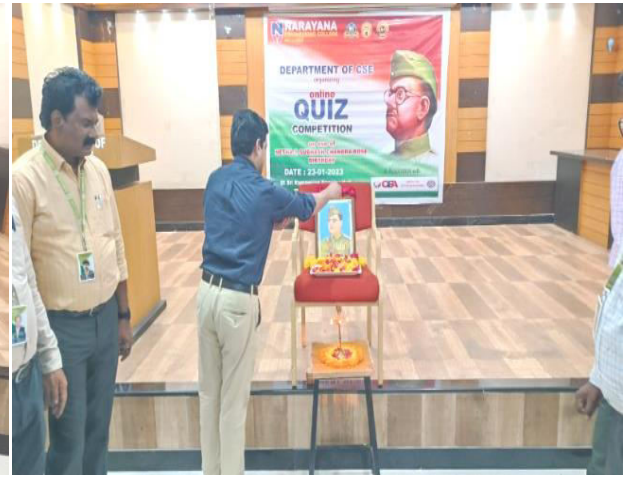
