#### A Brief Description of the Event:

The chief guest Mr.Srihari (Mandal Parishad Development Officer –MPDO-KOVURU), Mr. Krishnamurthy (Panchayathi Secretary-EO - Padugupadu), Mr.Dinesh Reddy-DLDA Director, Mr.Bhaskar Reddy-Jala Jeevana Mission Chairman, Mr. Kishore Singh, State Bondili sangham chairman, Mr. Lakshmi Narayana, Padugupadu Sarpanch, Kovuru, Mr.Ahamed Upa- Sarpanch and other dignitaries were welcomed by NSS volunteers..

NSS Programme Officer **Dr.M.chandramohan Reddy** emphasized the role of National Service Scheme (NSS) in the community service.

The Methodology is to create the awareness on Sun Stoke among the people of Padugupadu village through door to door campaign and distribution of pamphlet.

## **Brief Report of the Event:**

A free Medical Health Check-up camp was organized by NSS Unit of Narayana engineering College in Association with Narayana Medical College. The health checkup programme started at around 09:30am at Panchayat office in padugupadu village along with Dr. J.H.T.Jyothi (General Physician), Dr.K.Mamatha (Dental), NSS Programme Officer (Dr.M.chandramohan Reddy), and team from Narayana Medical College, Nellore.

Adopt a Patient program has been started where free medicines has been provided and follow ups to very sick patients who otherwise could not afford medical care. We are already taking care of one of the patients under this program.

General health checkup was done for people of padugupadu. 96 people enrolled their names for camp out of which 60 for General Health checkup and 36 for Dental checkup. Free drugs were dispensed. Main complaints among the adult population were related to back pain and knee pain and were treated symptomatically. The program was successfully conducted.

## **5.** A Report on Awareness on sapling plantation

## **Brief Report of the Event:**

At the Z.P. High School and Padugupadu Village in the Kovuru Mandal of the Nellore district, there is awareness of the planting of saplings. To raise awareness about sapling plantation, the volunteers strolled through Padugupadu. To engage the public, they displayed banners. The sapling plantation was still unknown to the residents of the village. 64 volunteers and Dr. M. Chandra Mohan Reddy, NSS Programme Officer, took part in this activity.

With the help of banners the volunteers, did door to door step in the village, to promote the importance of "Sapling Plantation". Nearly 100 saplings were planted in the village

and school as a part of village adoption. The program which was indented to promote environment development went on successfully with the close cooperation and involvement of village people and the NSS Student Volunteers.

SK Shaik Raheem- (Mandala Education Officer-MEO-Nellore District) explained about the Sapling plantation for ZP High School Children's. He said that trees contribute to their environment over long periods of time by providing oxygen, improving air quality, climate amelioration, conserving water, preserving soil, and supporting wildlife. During the process of photosynthesis, trees take in carbon dioxide and produce the oxygen we breathe.

NSS Students interact with the villagers and School Children's and explain about the trees contribute to their environment by providing oxygen, improving air quality, climate amelioration, conserving water, preserving soil, and supporting wildlife. During the process of photosynthesis, trees take in carbon dioxide and produce the oxygen we breathe. According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, "One acre of forest absorbs six tons of carbon dioxide and puts out four tons of oxygen. This is enough to meet the annual needs of 18 people." About 6 staff members and 64 students have actively participated in the Tree Plantation and planted the saplings in an organized way at padugupadu Streets and Z P High School campus.

## **Brief Report of the Event:**

Awareness on School Dropouts at Village and Z.p.High School padugupadu, Kovuru Mandal, Nellore district. They showcased banners to interact with the School children and Village people. The village people were still not aware about the School Dropouts. NSS Programme Officer (Dr.M.chandramohan Reddy) and 62 volunteers participated in this event.

We noticed from the words of the parents of our students in parents' meet that in their villages children are dropping their studies. Family's poor financial background, unawareness of the fruits of education or uneducated parents raises the number of drop outs. As highly qualified professionals of Narayana Engineering College, NSS Unit has organized an "Education – Awareness Program for School Drop outs" at padugupadu, ZPP High School, SPSR Nellore District.

Our faculty members and students gathered the dropouts of that school along with their parents and counselled them.

As a part of this NSS student Volunteers and First year students participated in the event. The program was initiated to create awareness about importance of education for dropout students, so that it will benefit the society and themselves as well. Many of us are better regarding financial condition so we are able to continue education till now...but this is not same for everyone.

Head Master Mr. Mohan Rao and Mr. Krishnamurthy (EO) explained about the school dropout, many people are unable to make their children educate due to their financial conditions, gender bias and many other reasons. So to witness the true side of society why many drop outs are still occurring especially in case of girls.

NSS Programme Officer and Student Volunteers went home to home in village and asked whether their children are studying or not? If no, we asked for the reasons and we told them the importance of education and how it creates impacts on life.

"Education replaces empty mind with positive thoughts."

Faculty created awareness on children's 'Right to Education Act' (RTE) of which most parents were unaware of free education, they were explained about free distribution of textbooks and uniforms, participation in extra-curricular activities and sports in school, hot midday meals for all children, health care and so on.

Our faculty members shared the information on various schemes like Shiksha Sahayog Yojana, Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan etc., started by the government with the parents of the dropout students. 62 students and 6 staff members have



participated in the event.

## Brief Report of the Event:

At the village and Z.P.High School in Padugupadu, Kovuru Mandal, Nellore district, there is awareness of Covid 19. To raise awareness of COVID 19, the volunteers circulated through the streets of Padugupadu. They displayed banners to engage the public. The Covid 19 was still unknown to the villagers. 62 volunteers and the NSS Programme Officer (Dr. M. Chandra Mohan Reddy) took part in this activity.

National Service Scheme (NSS) has conducted "Awareness on COVID Vaccine" on 18-03-2022 in one of the village adopted by the Narayana Engineering College i.e. Padugupadu. As a part of this NSS Volunteers from NSS Unit students participated in the event.

We urged the people not to believe in unauthenticated and false news spreading by social media. We have given information about corona and along with the precautions and symptoms.

## "STAY ALERT CONTROL THE VIRUS SAVE LIVES"

NSS Student Volunteers went through the streets of the village and explained through Pamphlets and slogans that maintaining social distance, wearing mask and using soap or sanitizer for hands protects the individual from novel corona virus infections. The rally also emphasized on keeping hands clean through proper methods of hand washing before eating and after defecation which keeps one free from disease causing bacteria and viruses

NSS Programme Officer explained about the mode of infection and control measures for COVID-19. He explained that COVID-19 is an infectious disease caused by novel Corona virus. It can also be transmitted from person to person. This virus spreads through droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose when an infected person coughs or sneezes. The disease is contagious and dangerous leading to deaths among human beings. The symptoms of COVID-19 H1N1 are fever, dry cough, headache, cold, sore throat, diarrhoea, loss of small or taste etc. It is recommended to visit the doctor as soon as a person suffers any of these symptoms.

He suggested the following steps to keep COVID-19 away:

1. The best way to prevent COVID-19 is maintaining social distance.

2. Highly recommended to wear masks on mouth and nose so that they do not intake the virus from the environment.

3. Wash your hands properly using soap or sanitizer. This prevents the virus to get into the body and infect us.

4. Avoid contact with people infected with corona virus.

Volunteers have covered the households by campaigning door to door in the village and distributed the pamphlets.
