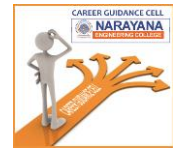

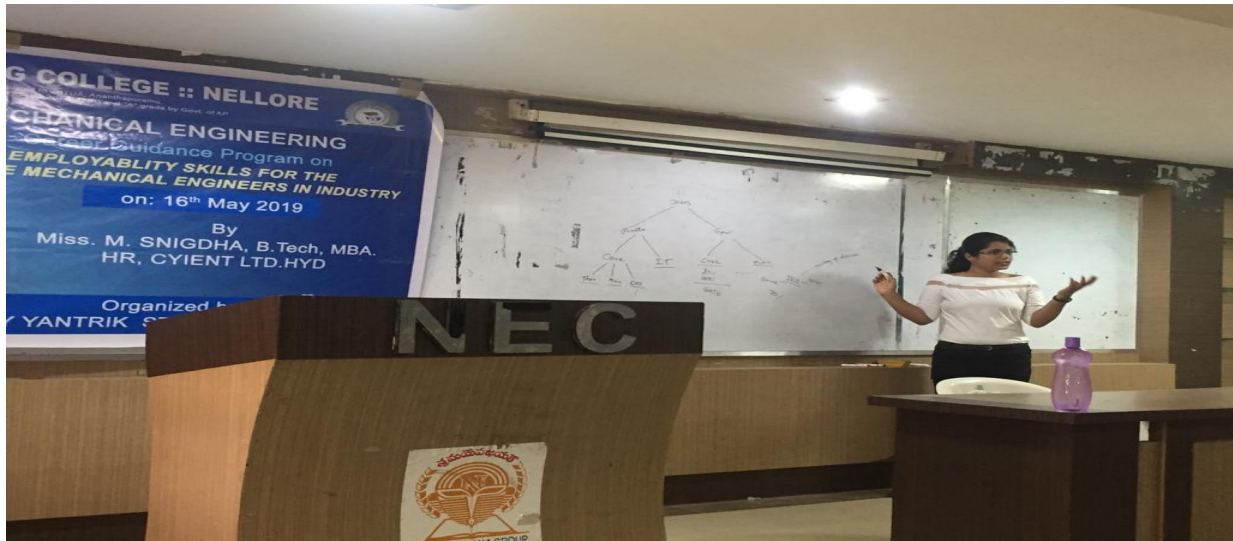

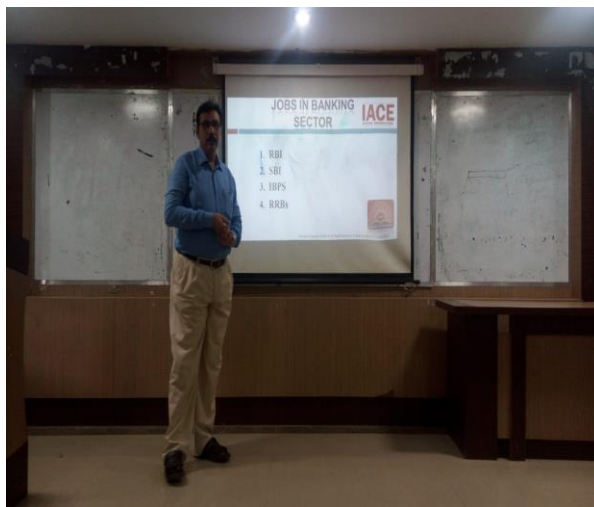
Ms.M.Snigdha explains about the required skills in industry

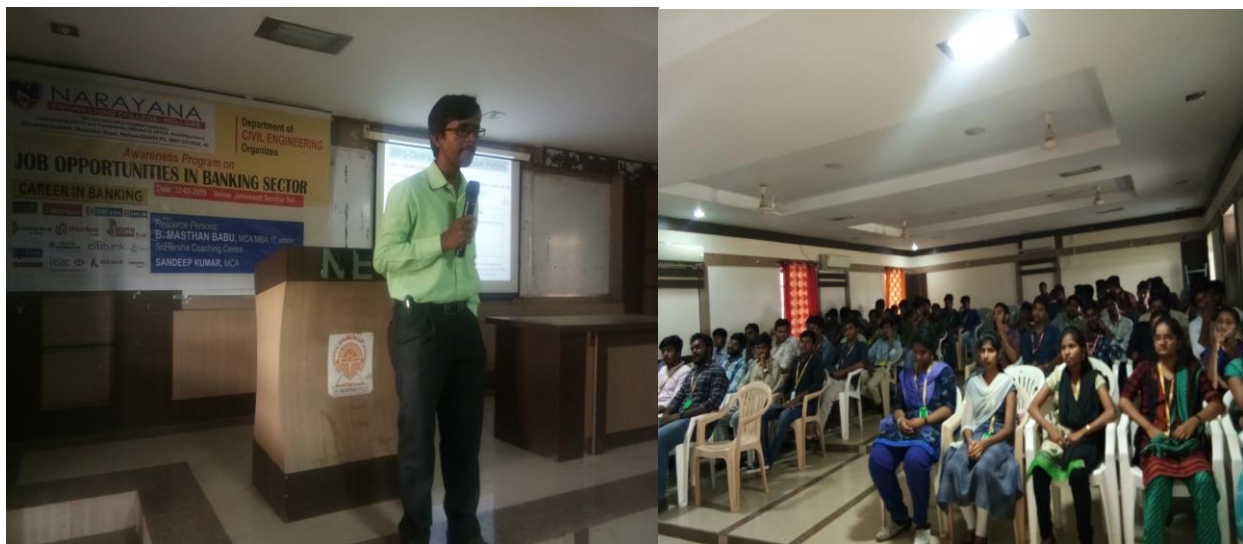
Figure 1: Resource Person addressing the gathering

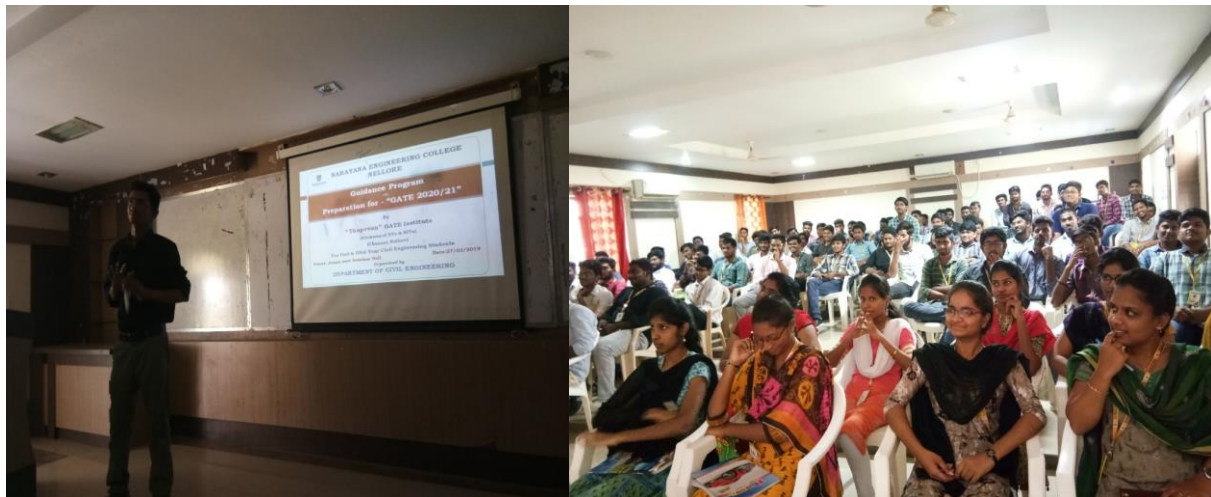

Booming IT sector in India has plenty of jobs for fresh computer science post graduates. Candidates with high percentage of mark and good communication skills as well as sound computer knowledge do not face problem in getting a job.

As a fresher, an MCA professional can expect anything around *2.4 to 3.4 lakhs*, and with experience, sky is the limit! With some years of experience, a Software Engineer can become a Lead, an Analyst, a Project Manager, a General Manager and so on. Initially MCA students are given a few weeks of training on the job, before they get started on LIVE projects. They need to work in different roles and areas in the beginning and then gradually specialize in a specific field. By this event students were knew new points, then the session was closed at 1.30 p.m.

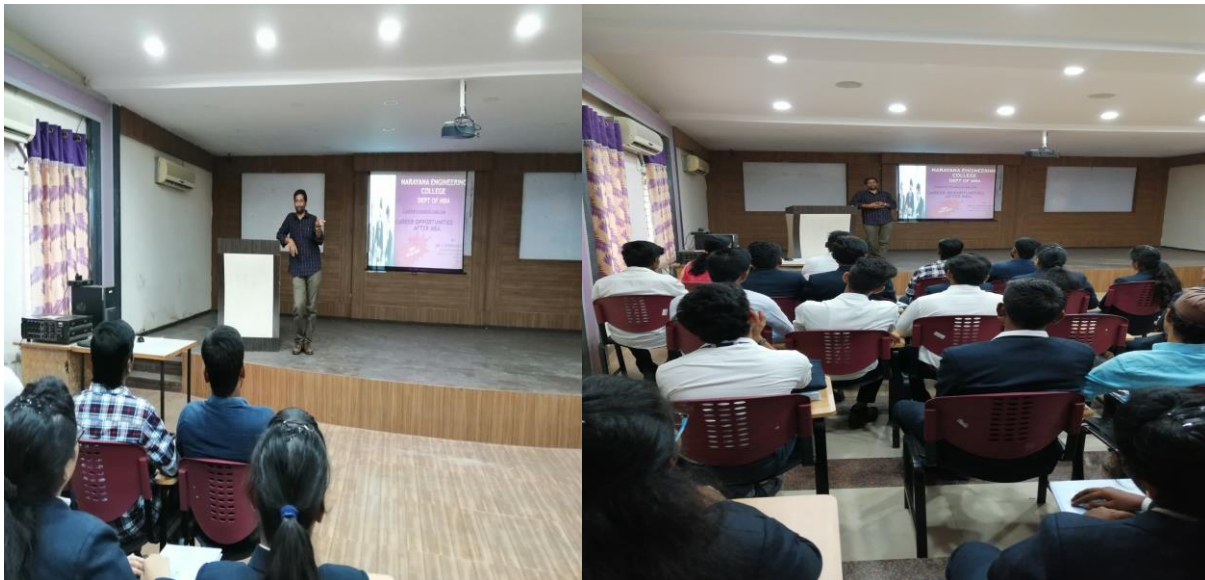

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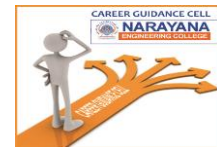
