REPORT ON ANTI RAGGING AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Anti Ragging Cell of Narayana Engineering College- Nellore was conducted the **ANTI RAGGING AWARENESS PROGRAMME** on 12th January 2023 with Police Administration of **Sri. Ramul Naik** (Circle Inspector VI Town - Nellore) & Principal **Dr.G. Srinivasulu Reddy** as key speakers of the orientation.

Initially the Principal **Dr.G. Srinivasulu Reddy** addressed the students & explained about AICTE, UGC, & JNT University Anti- Ragging guidelines. He also explained the legal consequences of involvement in such ragging activities. He also reiterated that anyone who is actively or passively, or is a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished.



Sri. Ramul Naik (Circle Inspector VI Town -Nellore) in his address to the students spoke about the origin and menace of Ragging in India and the different spheres to it. He also explained the legal consequences of involvement in such activities. He also reiterated that anyone who is actively or passively, or is a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished. Moreover,

he also briefed the students about the traffic regulations, their legal and health consequences if failed to adhere to them. He was addressed the students and explained 1) Whosoever, directly or indirectly, commits or participates in or abets or propagates ragging within or, outside any educational institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both. If the particular person committing or abetting ragging is not identified, every person participating in, or present at, such ragging activity shall be liable to punishment under the Act and collective punishment shall be resorted to so as to act as a deterrent punishment and to ensure collective pressure on the potential raggers.

Mr. S. Girish Gandhi also addressed the students and explained the legal consequences of involvement in such activities about the different strategies and action plan for curbing the menace of Ragging in the college by adopting various measures and activities. And he was explained Punishment for Participation in/or Abetment of Ragging :

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
5. Withholding results.
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- 10 Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-

The Students took the pledge not to involve themselves in ragging of any form and also to make the Institution Ragging free. The pledge was administered by

So that the action will be taken accordingly within 24 hours and the remedial measures/actions are to be carried out through various sections of the Indian Penal Code, laws from UGC and various other ragging welfare organizations.
