- The app comes with features to enable the public to register complaints, check FIR status and e-challans, file applications for passports, licences and no-

- objection certificates. This app comes with 87 services enabling citizens to file complaint and get FIR on smartphone.
- ➤ People can also alert the police on spotting a road accident, and it provides information about and directions to the nearest hospitals, blood banks and pharmacies. The app will also periodically update information about missing persons and unidentified dead bodies

- ➤ One Stop Centres (OSCs) are intended to support women affected by violence, in private and public spaces, within the family, community and at the workplace. - Focus on gender critical districts and cities.
