The objectives of this program is to Young people have to work through a broad range of issues as they move from childhood to adulthood. They may have to deal with



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changes to their bodies and their feelings and they may be thinking about having their first relationship or having sex.

There are 10 top health concerns for Girl child. They are Obesity, Alcohol and Drug Abuse, Injuries, Depression and Anxiety, Eating Disorders, Dating violence, Teen pregnancy, Internet and Smart phone risk, Teen tanning, Tattoos and Piercing

We could easily become overwhelmed worrying about your teenage daughter's health and well-being. Instead of worrying, talk to your daughter and be an active listener when she responds. Teens often lack the maturity and judgment skills needed to navigate many of these concerns. Make sure there are other trustworthy adults—relatives, teachers, youth leaders, coaches, doctors—she can turn to if she's hesitant to talk to you.

In this session Dr.K.MURALI, HOD of ECE addressed the gathering and introduced the resource persons, to the gathering. Later the resource persons discussed with the students about the importance of TEENAGE HEALTH ISSUES IN WOMEN. Smt.METHUKU RAJESWARI garu in her speech Overall, women are much more likely to see a doctor than men are, in part because women tend to seek medical advice more readily, but also, women are more prone to certain health problems. Regular doctor's visits are a great habit for women to have, considering the number of health issues life can bring. Here are eight of the most common health issues women face throughout their lives.

Symptoms of anxiety include:

- restlessness or feeling keyed up or on edge
- being easily fatigued
- difficulty concentrating or mind going blank
- irritability



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- muscle tension
- sleep disturbance (difficulty falling or staying asleep, or restless, unsatisfying sleep)

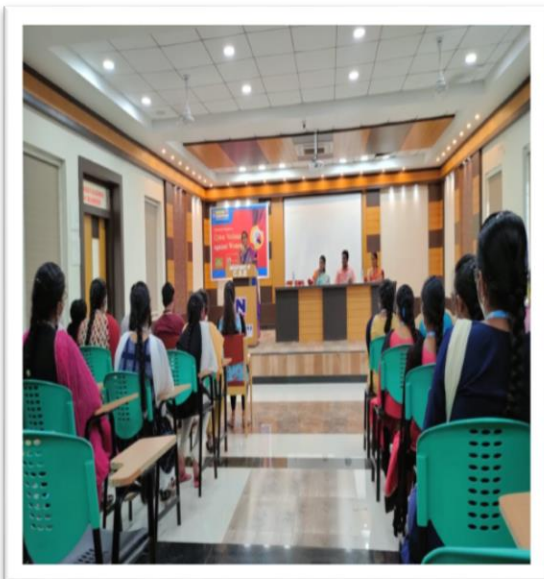

- A Program on "Women Protection-Legal Rights" was conducted on 11-02-2021, Thursday at Kautilya Seminar Hall, C-block. Mrs. A. Vijaya Lakshmi gave a speech about the problems that were being encountered by the women and also explained acts for those problems.
- She said reality is that we live in an increasingly violent society in which the fear of crime is ever-present. Personal safety has become an issue of importance for everyone, but especially for women.
- She gave some suggestions for girl students, how to protect themselves when they are alone that one should know about personal safety.

- She projected the concept of AP Police Seva app. The app developed by the AP police department incorporating state of the art technology includes 12 women safety features, emergency contact numbers besides legal help.
- AP Police Seva app aims to provide the services of the AP police department at people's doorstep.
- The app comes with features to enable the public to register complaints, check FIR status and e-challans, file applications for passports, licences and no-

objection certificates. This app comes with 87 services enabling citizens to file complaint and get FIR on smartphone.

- People can also alert the police on spotting a road accident, and it provides information about and directions to the nearest hospitals, blood banks and pharmacies. The app will also periodically update information about missing persons and unidentified dead bodies.

- One Stop Centres (OSCs) are intended to support women affected by violence, in private and public spaces, within the family, community and at the workplace. Women facing physical, sexual, emotional, psychological and economic abuse, irrespective of age, class, caste, education status, marital status, race and culture will be facilitated with support and redressal.
- Finally, Police seva app is very useful substantially minimize the need to approach police stations physically. Students acquired the knowledge in the session. The students actively participated and interacted with the resource person. The session is very useful to the students.

- The problems faced by women not only refer to domestic violence but also things like threats, unwanted visits and phone calls, insults, forced sex, and taking financial control. It has a great effect in many families. Even, Partner violence (a form of domestic violence) on women lead to depression and suicidal behavior.
- This program is designed to increase safety awareness, knowledge, skills, self-efficacy, and behaviors as well as social support for women.

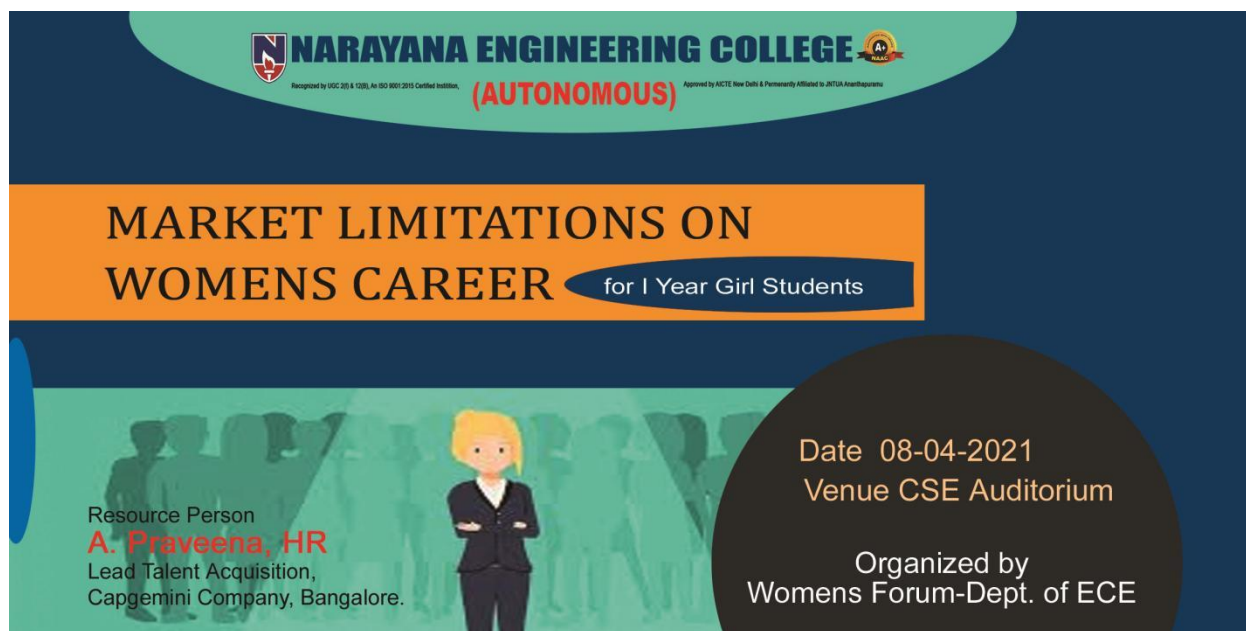

Praveena, HR, Lead Talent Aquisition, Capgemini Company, Bangalore, discussed with the students “MARKET LIMITATIONS ON WOMENS CAREER” Since the industrial revolution, participation of women in the workforce outside of the home has increased in industrialized nations, with particularly large growth seen in the 20th century. Largely seen as a boon for industrial society, women in the workforce contribute to a higher national economic output as measure in GDP as well as decreasing labor costs by increasing the labor supply in a society. She insisted her speech that Women’s lack of access to higher education had effectively excluded them from the practice of well-paid and high status occupations. Entry of women into the higher professions, like law and medicine, was delayed in most countries due to women being denied entry to universities and qualification for degrees. She concluded her speech that if the women are strong enough there are no limitations in the market on womens career

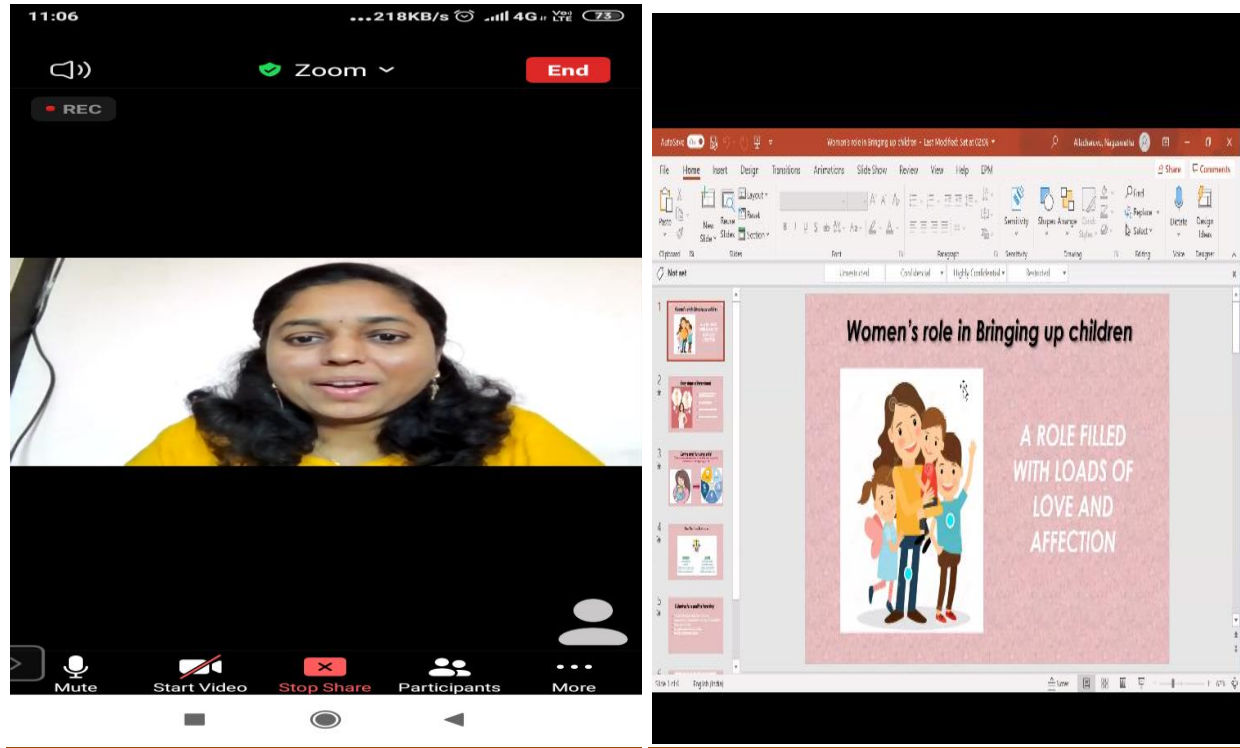
Mr. Swetha Allacheruvu also covered some of the important things in his session like caring and nurturing child, positive partnering, nurturing balance and how should develop in child.
