Career Guidance Cell has following facilities for proper functioning to carry out its day to day roles and responsibilities.


- Computer systems with internet connection,

Services provided by CG Cell:


- Helping student to fill up applications for higher studies, acquiring Letter of Recommendation and necessary documentation for admission in higher education.

- Inviting Entrepreneurs and encouraging student to choose Entrepreneurship as Career






