Report of Awareness Program on Medical Camp in Rural Area

Our college is located in central of Nellore city and is surrounded by many rural areas. Few of these villages have no healthcare facilities or even a qualified healthcare worker. To provide medical care to hundreds of people who would otherwise not be able to afford treatment, Department of EEE organised a one day general *Health & Medical Camp* in association with Narayana Medical College in the rural area of Golagamudi (vi), Nellore on 09-10-2018, with the help of students and staff members. Basic treatment and general check was provided to help people be aware of their health status. A team of doctors, nurses and a lab technician of Narayana Medical College were present to see that every patient is attended to. Referrals were made to the hospital and the biggest percentage of cases seen involve dengue and a few other illnesses such as flu, diarrhea, anaemia, etc. The camp was helpful for the local people as hospitals were located at a distant area from their place. Our team provided counselling and guidance on various health issues and Created awareness on different health issues by using interactive methods.

A total of 08 faculty members and 74 students from dept. Of EEE attended and made this program a successful one.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON DENGUE FEVER

In our city there are many educational institutions and even there are many schools in the context of our college. Dengue is the mosquito born viral disease spreading its tentacles all over the world. Dengue constitutes for major cause of deaths in children. According to WHO, globally it was estimated that approximately 70-100 million people were infected every year. Therefore, this awareness program has been conducted with the aim to assess knowledge regarding dengue fever among school children. Awareness among students is an important factor for preventing dengue in the community.

In view of this, on 14.8.2018 an awareness program was conducted at **Saint Army Aided Upper Primary School, Kondayapalem Gate, Nellore**. Majority of the village Children study in local government school only. Therefore, our Mechanical Engineering department has chosen this place to create awareness on the causes of this disease, symptoms, breeding places of mosquitoes and the preventive measures to be taken through the activities carried out to protect themselves from mosquito bites.

Faculty suggested the students, to wear long-sleeves and full pants to cover arms and legs, Use mosquito nets while sleeping. Make water puddles in and around your area to develop or create non-mosquito conditions by covering them with sand or dousing them with petrol/ kerosene or insecticides. Also, ensure that the drains are covered and not to allow overflowing. This health education will help transfer knowledge to school children and it can help establish sound knowledge about Dengue Fever prevention and in creating healthy life style practices for society as a whole, because "Prevention is always better than cure".

REPORT

A one day program on “**E-Learning**” was organized at PMR Municipal Corporation High School, Nellore. The faculty and student volunteers of MCA Department, Narayana Engineering College, Nellore has participated in the program. As it is a Govt. School, the school has few numbers of computers and a teacher to train the students in basics of computer and MS-Office only. Generally, in government schools the learners remain largely neglected in the advancement of technologies. Therefore our intention behind initiation of this program is to create awareness on the prospective of E-learning and its benefits over the regular learning in the classrooms or schools.

The faculty members explained the benefits of E-learning and demonstrated practically by opening the online websites like www.mathportal.org, **YouTube** lectures based on specific domains such as mathematics and physics. Faculty suggested students that it is possible for students to take classes that wouldn't normally be available to them in regular classroom. Faculty advised Students that they can learn any concept when they want and wherever they

want with their own speed. Besides these benefits, the faculty members also explained the limitations of E-Learning.

Fishermen Safety during cyclones*

Our college is located in the coastal area and one of the occupations of many uneducated people in the city of Nellore is fishing. The lives of fishermen remain undervalued by the government despite the dangers and perils involved in their occupation. The fisher folk from the coastal villages of Govindapalem are known for their skills in deep-sea fishing. Number of fishermen use to come from nearby villages to sell their fish. In order to maintain stability in their routine, they should be aware of better methods to save their lives and continue marketing even after a natural calamity like cyclone. At present, they are unaware of modern methods and equipments for safety during cyclone period. We have chosen this village to conduct an awareness programme to those fishermen to suggest how to safeguard themselves when warning about cyclone is announced by the government.

Department of Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering has initiated and organized an awareness program on “**Fishermen Safety during cyclones**” on 22-09-2018 at Govindapalem village, SPSR, Nellore.

The faculty advised the fishermen about

- To Keep boats/rafts properly tied up in a safe place
- Listen to/ rely on official warnings
- Drink boiled/ chlorinated water
- Seek a safe shelter as soon as possible
- Lock the homes, switch off power, gas, water connections/points, and keep emergency kit with them.

A total of 74 members from dept. of EIE discussed the inherent difficulties explaining the causalities and precautionary measures to be taken during cyclones.
