	Remarks/suggestions: Conducted bridge courses for required subjects.
6	Tutorial Classes
	Observations: Tutorial classes were conducted for 6 subjects as per the course structure and files were maintained.
	Remarks/suggestions: Good number of tutorial classes was conducted.
7	Remedial classes/Remedial coaching
	Observations: It was observed that remedial classes for 10 subjects were conducted for slow learners identified from Unit-I, MID-I, Unit-II for II, III and final year students. Remedial Coaching was provided for few subjects.

	Remarks/suggestions: Good number of industrial visits was organized.
10	Student seminars
	Observations: It was observed that, student seminars were conducted in the first half of the semester as per the schedule and second cycle student seminars are conducted but not as per the schedule.
	Remarks/suggestions: It is suggested to conduct student seminars as per schedule without any deviations and definitely second cycle lab seminars should also be completed without fail.
11	Lecture Schedule verification
	Observations: It was observed that syllabus coverage was verified based on lecture schedule eight times in the semester and it was observed that few topics were deviated from the lesson plan.
	Remarks/suggestions: It is suggested to take up extra classes to complete the syllabus as per schedule.
12	Lab Records/Manuals
	Observations: It was observed that stock registers and lab manuals are updated. Lab manuals are evaluated up to date.
	Remarks/suggestions: Soft copies and hard copies of all lab manuals for each semester should be maintained in the department without fail for future reference.
13	Laboratory maintenance
	Observations: Files maintained properly
	Remarks/Suggestions: It is suggested to update files for laboratory maintenance which includes the number of equipment in condition, under repair, etc. All this information should


	be updated on day to day basis. It is mandatory to maintain all these records. This information will be useful for further references.
14	Laboratory (Equipment): Status
	Observations It is observed that in ECAD LAB some parts of computers are under maintenance.
