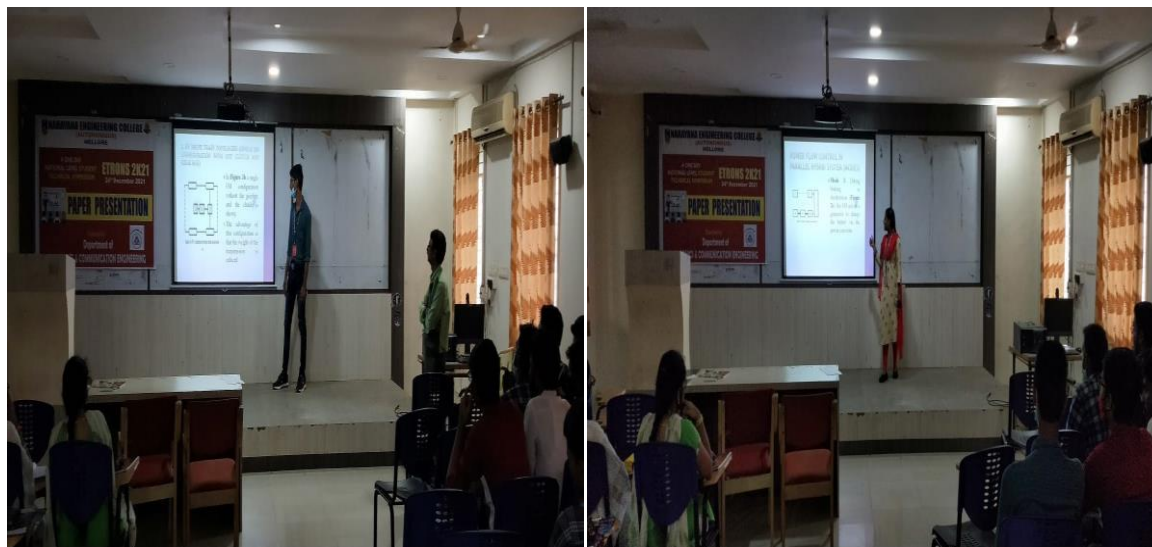
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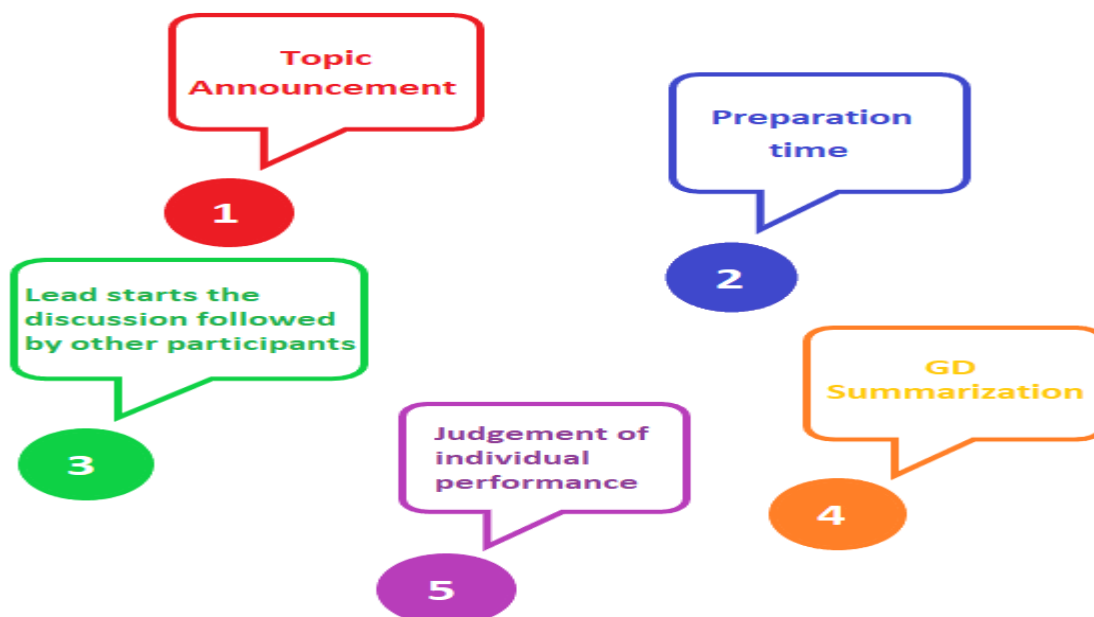
Sakala " Group Discussion ":

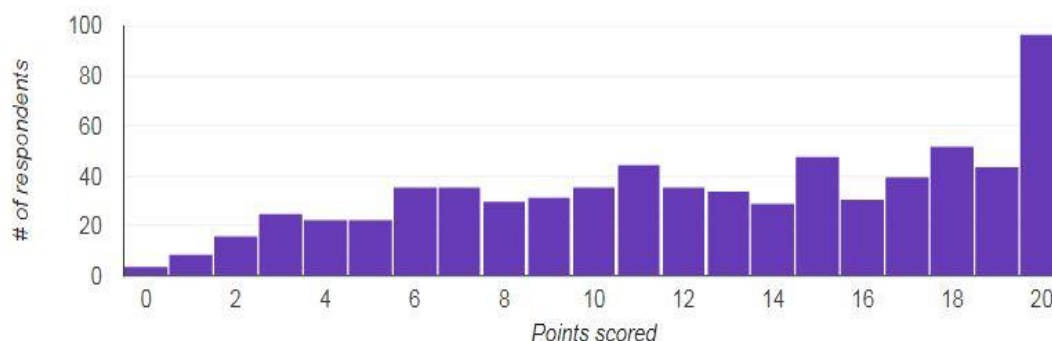

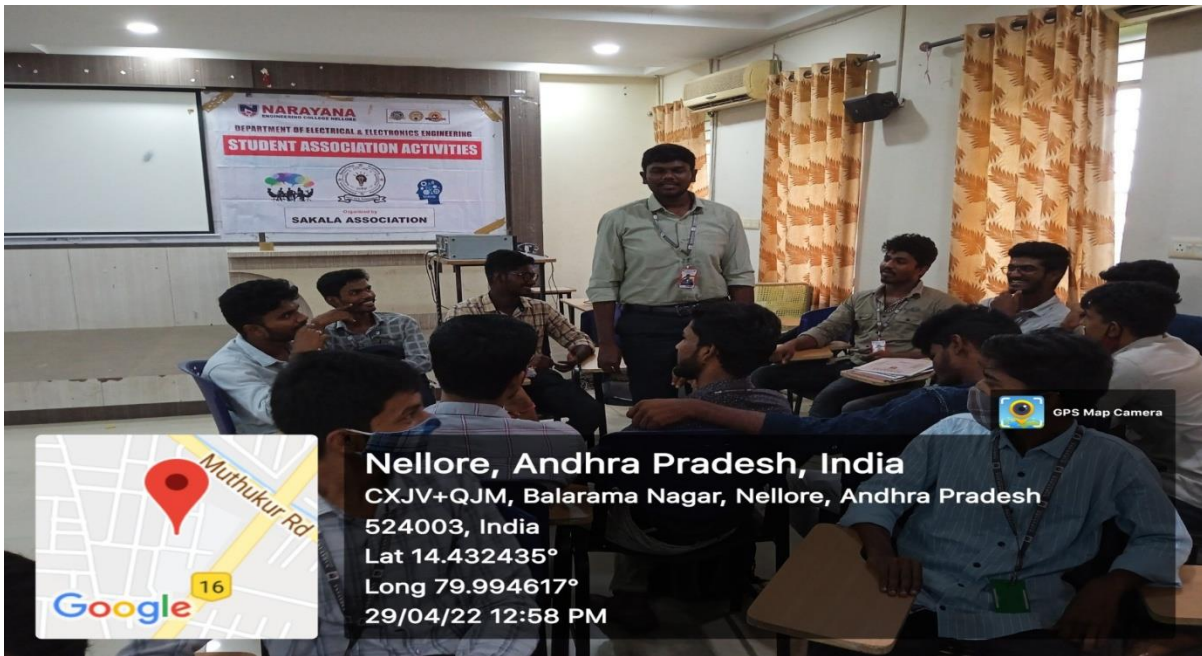
One must be well organized in order to make the audience understand the purpose of the talk

Tips for presentation

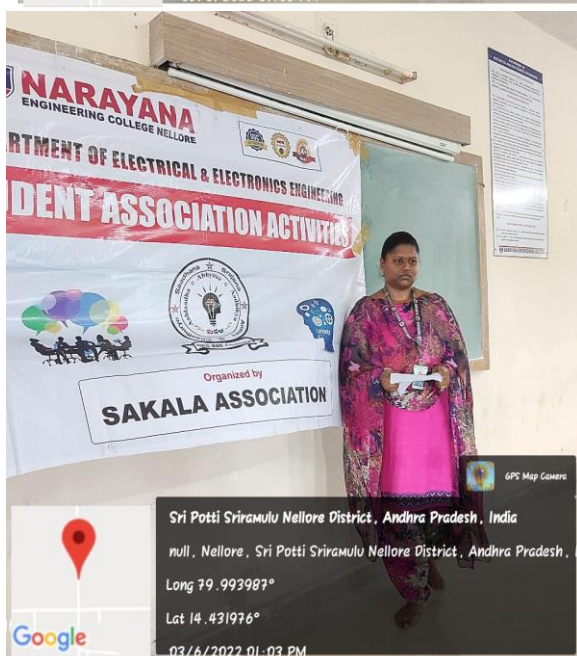
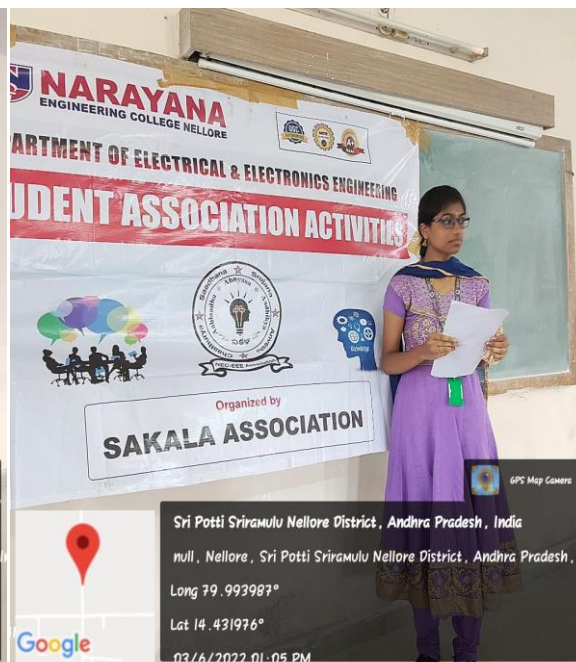
- Be careful with the time as you might run short of time.
